Agenda Item No. 1: Confirmation of MoM of 21st IQAC meeting and informing about ATR of the same.

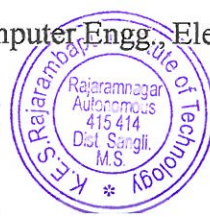

- Dr. L. M. Jugulkar, Dean – Student Development, briefed about the submission of the CSR Funds proposal to the Industries. Dr. M. S. Deshmukh, University Representative, suggested registering on the Central Government CSR Portal.
- Dr. S. K. Patil, Dean – Academics, briefed on the initiative of collaborative work for developing the faculty expertise in the field of Foundry Engineering.
- All the IQAC Members confirmed the MoM and ATR of the 21st IQAC Meeting.

Agenda Item No. 2: To brief about RIT's ongoing academic schedule and planning.

- Dr. S. K. Patil, Dean - Academics briefed about the ongoing academic schedule and planning for the upcoming semester for F.Y. B. Tech, F. Y. M. Tech, F.Y. MBA, S.Y. B. Tech, T.Y. B. Tech, Final Year B. Tech, S.Y. MBA & S.Y. M. Tech.
- Dr. M. S. Deshmukh, Director – IQAC, Shivaji University Kolhapur suggested for implementation of on-demand examinations.

Agenda Item No. 3: To inform about the recent NBA accreditations and status.

- Dr. Satyajit R. Patil, Dean – Quality Assurance, informed the members about the recently accredited three UG Programs (Computer Engg., Electrical Engg., Electronics



& Telecommunication Engg.) and one PG Program (Mechanical Design Engg.) for three years i.e., 01/07/2022 to 30/06/2025 based on the NBA visit held during 20th to the 22nd of January 2023. Dr. M. S. Deshmukh and all external members congratulated RIT for being accredited by NBA for three years.

Further, he informed about the forthcoming NBA accreditation process for one UG program (Mechanical Engg.) and two PG programs (Computer Science & Engg., Power Systems and Power Electronics)

- Dr. Satyajit R. Patil, Dean – Quality Assurance, informed that the overall percentage of programs accredited by the NBA currently stands at 71.42%.

Agenda Item No. 4: To inform about the feedback received from the recent NBA accreditation committee.

Agenda Item No. 5: To discuss and formulate strategies for increasing the number of Ph.D. faculty members at RIT.

- Mrs. Sarika D. Patil, the Registrar, presented the statistics for the number of Ph.D. faculty members available in RIT.
- Hon. R. D. Sawant, Management Representative, directed to collect information regarding the number of faculty members who have registered and not registered for Ph. D. from each department. Also, he suggested estimating the number of Ph.D. faculty members who will be awarded the Ph.D. within 1-2 years span.

- Dr. M. B. Mandale, Head of the Science & Humanities Department, presented the Research & Development Activities of the department, along with a brief about the completed and ongoing R&D Projects.

Mandale, Head of the Science & Humanities Department, suggested focusing on teaching activities of the Science & Humanities Department KRA Targets; as the department lags in Consultancy.



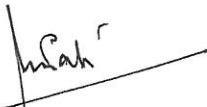
Agenda Item No. 7: To discuss and explore possibilities for teachers awarded national/international fellowships for advanced studies/research.
