"INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY"

The world commemorates women today under the hashtag #BreakTheBias.

The theme for this year's International Women's Day is: **"Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow."**

This year's campaign is represented by the #BreakTheBias hashtag and calls on people to work towards a world that is equitable, inclusive, and free from bias and discrimination so the playing field is levelled for women moving forward.

"We have today the opportunity to put women and girls at the centre of our planning and action and to integrate gender perspectives into global and national laws and policies," Sima Bahous, executive director of UN Women, said.

The predecessor of International Women's Day, previously known as National Women's Day, was first observed in the United States on February 28, 1909, at the suggestion of activist Theresa Malkiel.

The idea of an international women's day was unheard of until 1910 during an International Socialist Women's Conference that took place in Copenhagen, Denmark.

It was during this conference that Clara Zetkin, a German communist activist, universal suffragist and advocate of women's rights, proposed the idea that there be a designated day for women everywhere to "press for their demands". Her idea was met with unanimous approval from all the women present representing 17 countries.

International Women's Day was first celebrated in Austria, Denmark, Germany and Switzerland on March 19, 1911, following the agreement at the Copenhagen conference. Russia celebrated its first International Women's Day two years later on the last Sunday of February – February 23, 1913.

Why is International Women's Day celebrated on March 8?

The most consequential International Women's Day protest took place in Russia on March 8, 1917. Thousands of Russian women took to the streets of the capital, Petrograd, now known as St Petersburg, to demand the end of food shortages and World War I. It was this International Women's Day protest that helped prompt the start of the Russian Revolution and led to the overthrowing of the czar. This holiday has been celebrated on March 8 ever since, as it took place on February 23, 1917, on the then-used Julian calendar (the equivalent of March 8 on the Gregorian calendar).

When was International Women's Day recognised worldwide?

The United Nations celebrated International Women's Day for the first time in 1975.



According to Women Watch, the UN General Assembly cited two reasons for deciding to observe the celebration of women's day: the first is to recognise the fact that securing peace and social progress and the full enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms require the active participation, equality and development of women. The second is to acknowledge the contribution of women to the strengthening of international peace and security.

विष्णू वामन शिरवाडकर उर्फ कुसुमाग्रज यांचा जन्मदिवस २७ फेब्रुवारी हा मराठी भाषा गौरव दिन म्हणून साजरा केला जातो. १९९९ मध्ये ज्ञानपीठ पुरस्कारप्राप्त व्यक्तींच्या निधनानंतर सरकारने कुसुमाग्रजांची जयंती मराठी राजभाषा गौरव दिन म्हणून साजरी करण्यास सुरवात केली. आपल्या मराठी भाषेबद्दल विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये ओढ निर्माण व्हावी. मराठी भाषा समृद्ध व विकसित करण्यासाठी विद्यार्थी मध्ये जागृती निर्माण करणे या उद्देशाने मराठी भाषा दिनाचे औचित्य साधून "अभिजात मराठी" या विषयावर लायब्ररी कट्टा घेण्यात आला

- अभिजात मराठी या विषयावर पुढील प्रमाणे चर्चा करण्यात आली

मराठी भाषेबद्दल विद्यार्थीना विचार जाणून घेण्याचा प्रयत्न केला. महाराष्ट्रात मराठी भाषेबद्दल निश्चीत असे धोरण नाही. इंग्रजी भाषेचा विनाकारण बाऊ केला जातो तर मराठी भाषेसाठी न्यूनगंड बाळगला जातो. त्यामुळे मराठी भाषा बोलता लिहिता वाचता येत असून ती जास्त न वापरल्या मुळे तिचा विकास होत नाही. महाराष्ट्राची राजभाषा मराठी असून पण व्यवहारात मराठी एवजी इतर भाषांना महत्व दिले जाते. त्यामुळे मराठीचे आपल्याच राज्यात प्रभुत्व कमी होत असल्याचे विद्यार्थींनी खंत व्यक्त केली.

- मराठी भाषा व संस्कृती

भाषा ही एखाद्या कुटुंबाप्रमाणे असते. प्रत्येक भाषेचं वेगळं वैशिष्ट्य असतं. यामध्ये उपभाषा, पोटभाषा, बोलीभाषा, लिपी या सगळ्यांचा गोतावळा असतो. परंपरा आणि सांस्कृतिक वारसा टिकवून ठेवण्याचं कार्य भाषेच्या माध्यमातून केलं जातं. भाषेमुळेच संस्कृतीची देवाणघेवाण होते. पण एखादी भाषा किंवा त्यातील बोली लोप पावत असेल तर त्याचा दूरगामी परिणाम संस्कृतीवरही होतो. त्यामुळेच की काय, भाषा हा कोणत्याही संस्कृतीच्या अस्मितेचा विषय मानला गेला आहे. महाराष्ट्राचे भौगोलिक आणि राजकीय दृष्ट्या पाच भाग पडलेले आहेत. त्यामध्ये खानदेश, विदर्भ, मराठवाडा, कोकण आणि उर्वरित महाराष्ट्र यांचा समावेश आहे. याशिवाय कर्नाटक-तेलंगणच्या सीमावर्ती भागाचाही विचार केला जातो. सध्याच्या काळात महाराष्ट्रात वैदर्भीय बोली, मराठवाडी बोली, कोकणातील बोली आणि उर्वरित महाराष्ट्रातील कोल्हापुरी, आगरी, पुणेरी, मालवणी, वऱ्हाडी,



झाडीबोली, अहिराणी, डांगी, कोकणी या अशा अनेक बोलींचा मराठीत समावेश आहे. यातील बहुतांश भाषा व त्याची परंपरागत संस्कृति लोप पावत चालली आहे.

• समृद्ध मराठी

मराठी जगवायची असेल तर तिला ज्ञानभाषा बनवणे, तिच्यापासून पैसा मिळेल याची सोय करणे, तिच्यामध्ये अधिकाधिक बिझनेस ट्रांजेक्शन होतील याची खबरदारी घेणे हे महत्त्वाचे उपाय आहेत. दैनंदिन जीवनात फक्त मराठी चाच वापर करावा सोशल मीडिया, व्हाट्सअप्प, ट्विटर, फेसबुक हि एप्स मराठीतच वापारावीत प्रत्येक अमराठी माणसाशी आवर्जून मराठी मधेच संवाद साधावा व मराठी भाषा वापरणे किती गरजेचे आहे याची जाणीव त्यांना करून द्यावी मराठी वर्तमानपत्र वाचावेत आठवड्यात कमीत कमी १० लोकांना मराठीत बोलण्यासंदर्भात बोलण्याची जरूरी ह्याचे महत्त्व पटवून द्यावे. आशा प्रकारे मराठी भाषा जास्तीत जास्त वापरून तिचा विकास व समृद्ध करणे हा गरजेचे आहे चर्चेतून विद्यार्थ्यांना जाणीव झाली.

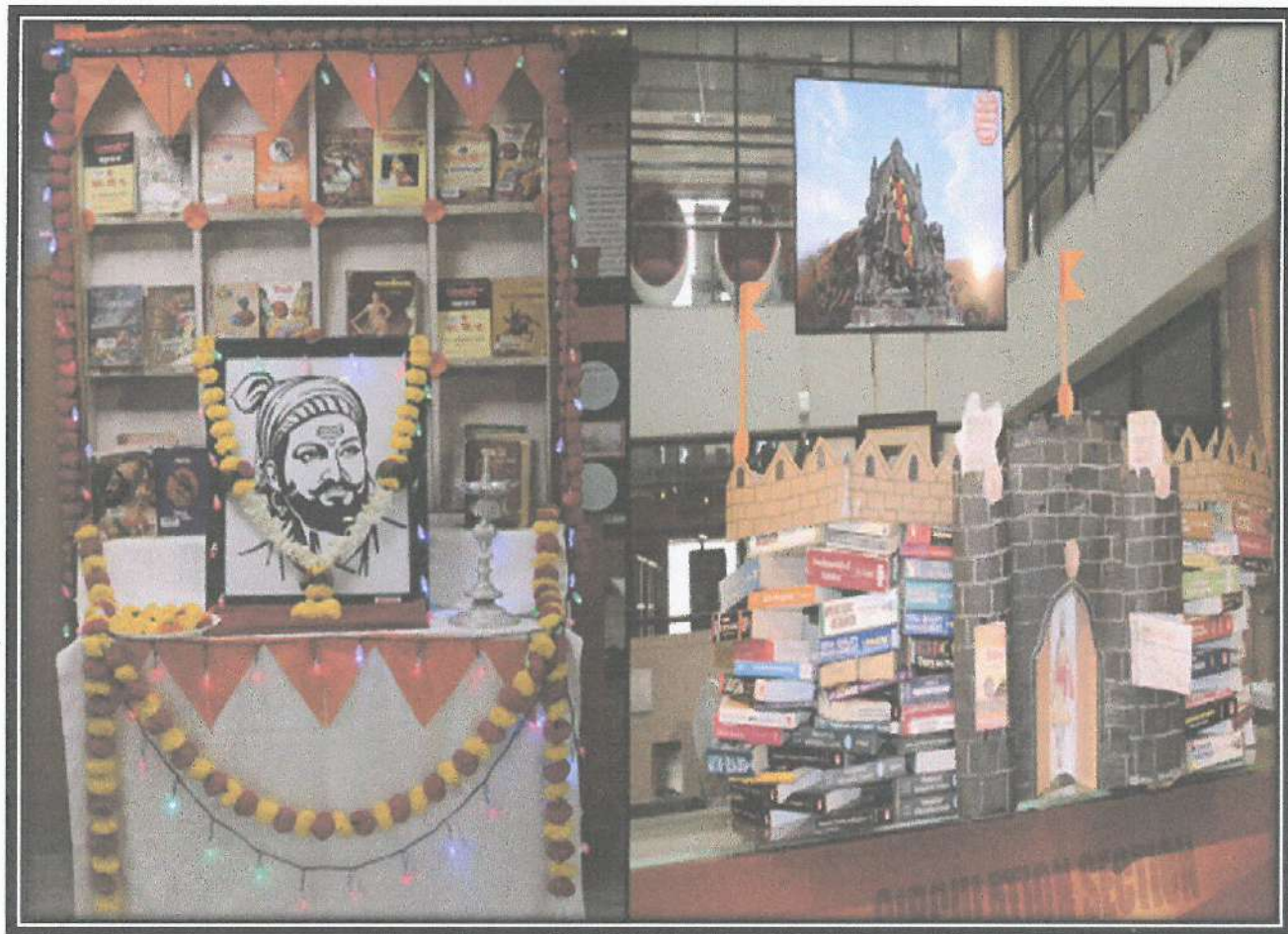

"SHIVJAYANTI"

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti is a festival and public holiday of the Indian state of Maharashtra. This festival is celebrated on February 19 (according to Julian date), celebrating the birth anniversary of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the first Chhatrapati and founder of the Maratha Empire. He reestablished Hindavi Swarajya [Hindavi Svarājya; "Self-Rule of the Hindu people"]. Some people celebrate this day as per Hindu Calendar in Maharashtra.

In 1870, Mahatma Phule started celebration of Shivaji Jayanti, which was then taken forward by Bal Gangadhar Tilak.^{[3][4]}

Shiv Jayanti is the birth anniversary of great Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj. Shiv Jayanti is celebrated every year on Indian Solar 30th Magh or Gregorian 19 February. Shivaji Maharaj was born on Indian Solar Magh 30, 1551/Gregorian February 19, 1630, in Shivneri Fort. Shivaji Maharaj is considered as the greatest Maratha ruler who carved an enclave from the declining Adilshahi sultanate of Bijapur that became the start of the Maratha Empire. At the young age of 16, Shivaji Maharaj seized the Torna fort and by the age of 17 had seized the Raigad and Kondana forts. Shivaji Maharaj as he is popularly known was named Shivaji Bhosale and was a member of the Bhonsle Maratha clan. Shivaji Maharaj promoted the use of Marathi and Sanskrit in court and administration, rather than using Persian which was the norm in those times.

In Maharashtra Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj is a "Aaradhya Daiwat" of all marathas.

Celebration of Shivjayanti at RIT Central Library

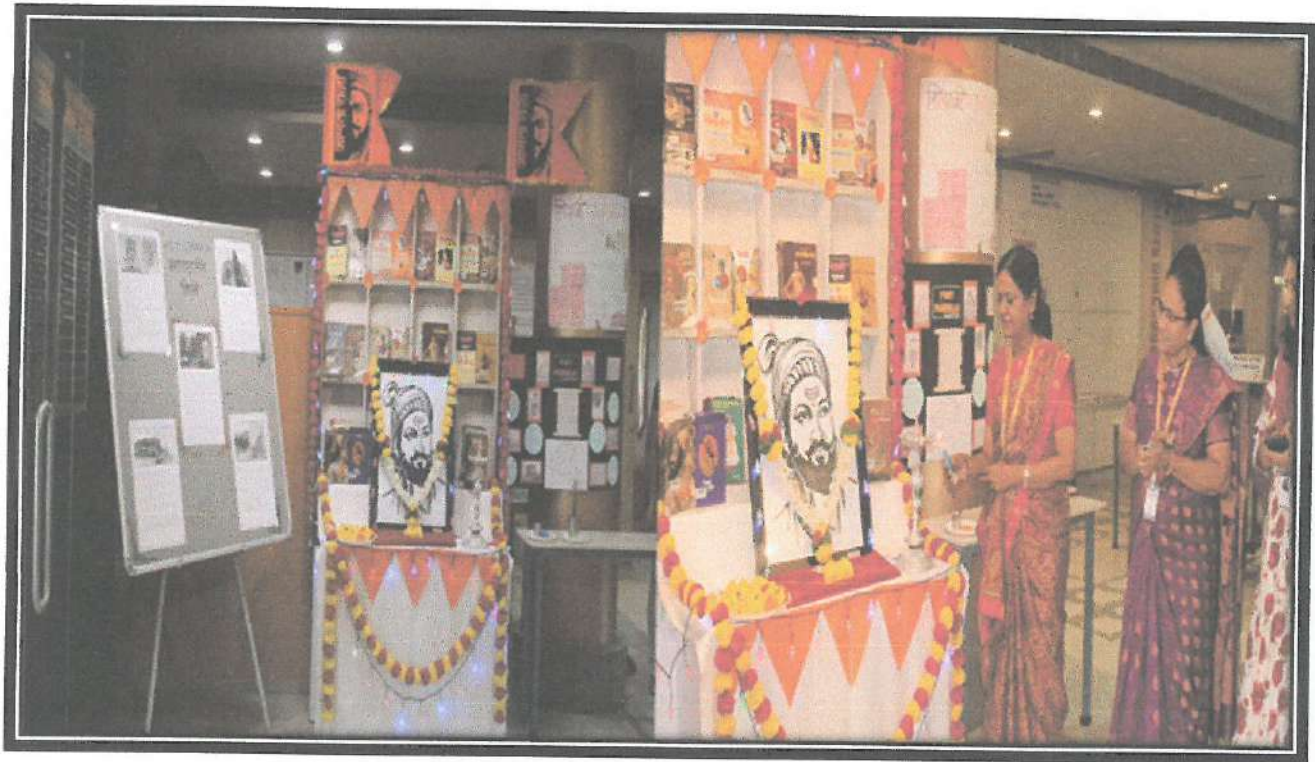
Various forts information with photo's also displayed at that time for giving information about various forts to readers.

"INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY (SWAMI VIVEKANAND JAYANTI)"

Swami Vivekananda (12 January 1863 – 4 July 1902), Narendranath Datta was an Indian Hindu monk and philosopher. He was a chief disciple of the 19th-century Indian mystic Ramakrishna. Influenced by Western esotericism, he was a key figure in the introduction of the Indian darsanas (teachings, practices) of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world, and is credited with raising interfaith awareness, bringing Hinduism to the status of a major world religion during the late 19th century. He was a major force in the contemporary Hindu reform movements in India, and contributed to the concept of nationalism in colonial India. Vivekananda founded the Ramakrishna Math and the Ramakrishna Mission. He is perhaps best known for his speech which began with the words "Sisters and brothers of America ...," in which he introduced Hinduism at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago in 1893.

Born into an aristocratic Bengali Kayastha family of Calcutta, Vivekananda was inclined towards spirituality. He was influenced by his guru, Ramakrishna, from whom he learnt that all living beings were an embodiment of the divine self; therefore, service to God could be rendered by service to humankind. After Ramakrishna's death, Vivekananda toured the Indian subcontinent extensively and acquired first-hand knowledge of the conditions prevailing in British India. He later travelled to the United States, representing India at the 1893 Parliament of the World's Religions. Vivekananda conducted hundreds of public and private lectures and classes, disseminating tenets of Hindu philosophy in the United States, England and Europe. In India, Vivekananda is regarded as a patriotic saint, and his birthday is celebrated as National Youth Day.

Every year on January 12, India celebrates National Youth Day, also known as Yuva Diwas, to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda, who was one of the most prominent philosophers, monks, and thinkers of India. This day was first declared as National Youth Day in 1984 by the government of India to pay tribute and honor the teachings of Vivekananda. Since then, Rashtriya Yuva Diwas is celebrated all across the country.

National Youth Day 2022: Theme

Every year, the government of India decides the theme of National Youth Day, which is different from the previous one and purely based on the teachings of Swami Vivekananda. This year the theme for National Youth Day 2022 is "It's all in the mind," which is a key teaching of Vivekananda.

Swami Vivekananda saw hope for the country in every child as he believed with "muscles of iron" and "nerves of steel" children and the young could bring about social change.

In India, several states organize events every year to commemorate this special day. Many government organizations and non-profit organizations participate and plan events for National Youth Day.

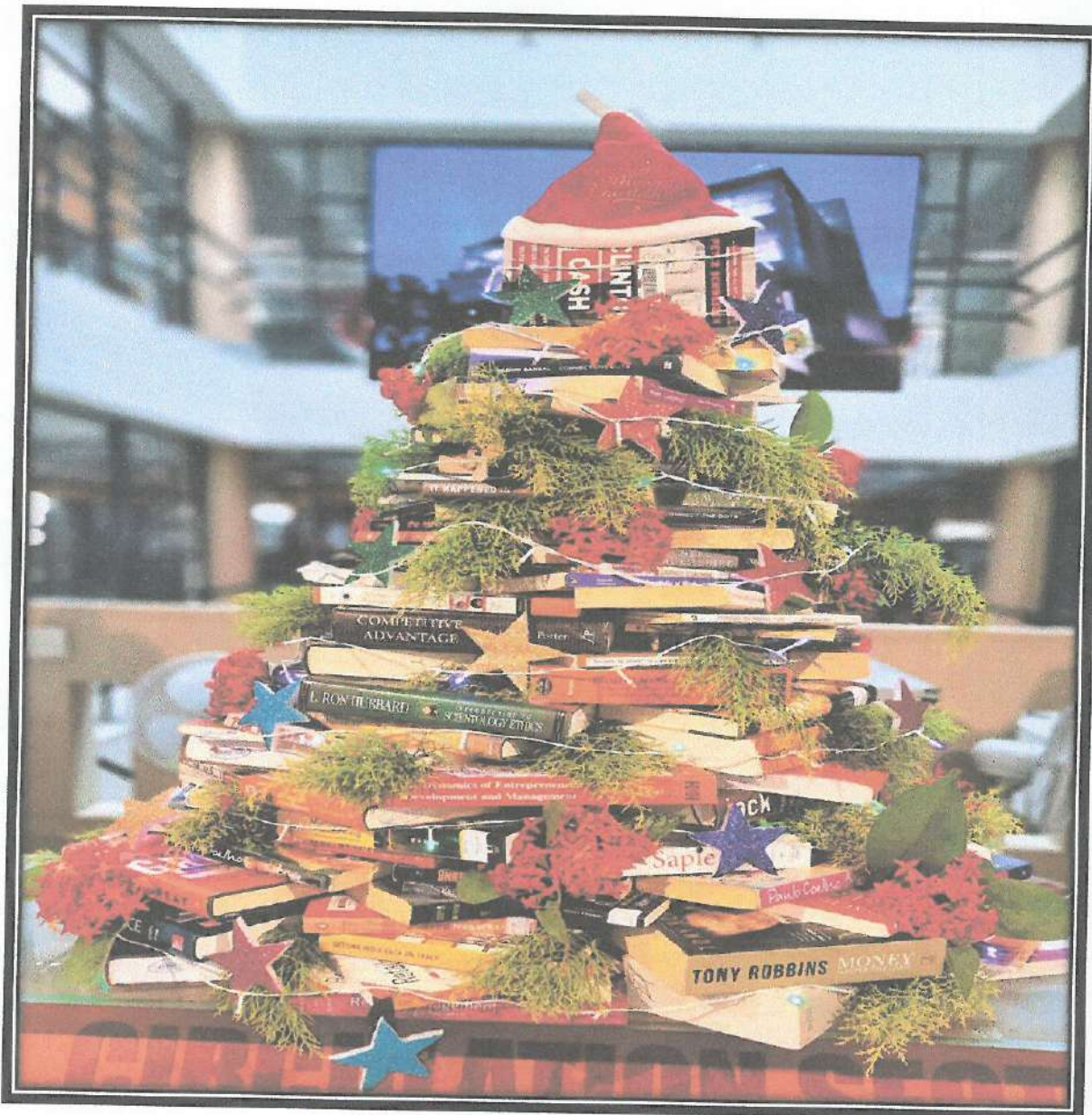

The earlier term Yule may have derived from the Germanic jöl or the Anglo-Saxon geöl, which referred to the feast of the winter solstice. The corresponding terms in other languages—Navidad in Spanish, Natale in Italian, Noël in French—all probably denote nativity. The German word Weihnachten denotes "hallowed night." Since the early 20th century, Christmas has also been a secular family holiday, observed by Christians and non-Christians alike, devoid of Christian elements, and marked by an increasingly elaborate exchange of gifts. In this secular Christmas celebration, a mythical figure named Santa Claus plays the pivotal role.

Origin and development

The early Christian community distinguished between the identification of the date of Jesus' birth and the liturgical celebration of that event. The actual observance of the day of Jesus' birth was long in coming. In particular, during the first two centuries of Christianity there was strong opposition to recognizing birthdays of martyrs or, for that matter, of Jesus. Numerous Church Fathers offered sarcastic comments about the pagan custom of celebrating birthdays when, in fact, saints and martyrs should be honoured on the days of their martyrdom—their true "birthdays," from the church's perspective.

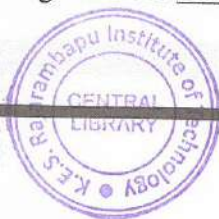
Many Christians in India celebrate Jesus Christ's birth on on Christmas Day, which is annually held on December 25. The celebrations are most noticeable in states where there are many Christians. Christmas Day is a gazetted holiday in India.

Many Christians mark Christmas Day by attending special church services, spending time with family members, wearing new clothes and eating a festive meal. Some families exchange gifts or give small presents or sweets to children. They may display small electric lamps or small clay oil-burning lamps and decorate their homes with banana or mango leaves. Some also put up a nativity scene with clay figures or a Christmas tree. Christmas trees in India are usually imitation pine trees or branches of native trees or bushes.

Meaning & Significance of Christmas Tree

The Christmas tree is considered as the symbol of eternal life. As the festival of Diwali is incomplete without flickering oil lamps, Holi without the splash of vibrant colours, Raksha Bandhan without the pious Rakhi. Similarly, the festival of Christmas is incomplete with a Christmas tree. Christmas tree-- an evergreen pine, spruce, or fir decorated with lights and glittery ornaments with a bright star shining at the top. Christmas tree is symbolic of birth and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The tree's branches and shrubs are viewed as an emblem of immortality and are said to symbolize the crown of thorns worn by Christ on the cross. Also, every decoration used to adorn the Christmas tree is believed to have a special significance. Though, people choose the ornaments for decorating as per their choice.

- The bells hanging at the side of the tree branches represent the joy and happiness of this day.
- The candy cane-shaped, like shepherd's crook, represents God's shepherd.
- The wreath is an epitome of true love.
- The **Star** represents the Star of Bethlehem which guided the Three Wise Men to the stable where Jesus was born.

Topic 21. Save Environment

The academic year 2021-22 is underway. New students are entering college. covid 19 academic year is starting with enthusiasm. And this was the first Library Katta for students this academic year. With Kovid, the environment has changed a lot, but the library group was organized on the topic of Save environment. The following topics were discussed among the students in this session Save Environment

- Ø What is the atmosphere? An atmosphere is a mantle made up of air, vapor, and dust around an object with sufficient mass. Due to the gravity of the object, the mantle stays around the earth.
- Ø What is climate change? - To understand this, let us consider the earth in relation to the green house. Just as a greenhouse produces abundant produce by creating a close system or controlled conditions that are conducive to the desired crop, so too is a greenhouse-like close system naturally established by the Earth's atmosphere and its ozone layer. The ozone layer is the green cloth of the greenhouse and the environment is the controlled environment inside the greenhouse. The balance of the various gases in the space under the ozone layer is based on temperature parameters. The ozone layer is the green cloth that acts to block the harmful rays (ultraviolet rays) coming from the sun to the earth. At a time when the environment was in equilibrium, so were the rainy, winter, and summer conditions of your childhood that you experienced in the table above. This was due to the equilibrium between the amount of different gases in the atmosphere around the earth at that time and the average temperature of the earth. This means that if we create such a balance today, we can bring rain, cold and heat or summer just like that time. That is, changes in the proportions and average temperatures of various gases in the Earth's atmosphere are called 'climate change'.
- Ø Causes of climate change? - The causes of climate change are classified as natural and man-made. We will discuss this briefly.

1) Natural Causes - These include tilting the Earth's axis by half a degree after 100 years, displacement of land, volcanoes, forest fires, and the condition of hot and cold currents in the oceans, all of which have little to do with mankind. However, with proper control of man-made causes, we can achieve favorable conditions for humans and ecosystems, just as the A.C. By applying it, we can keep the condition of our house as we want. It is important to note that while decision-making and implementation at home is strictly monolithic, the collective and unilateral efforts of 700 million people on earth are desperately needed.



2) Man-made causes - Increased levels of methane, carbon dioxide, phosphates and nitrates in the atmosphere (these gases are called greenhouse gases - have two effects). One - Green house gases efficiently absorb heat from the sun on the earth, this heat is carried everywhere by the vapor / vapor in the atmosphere and helps to increase the average temperature of the earth. And two - the excess of these gases dilutes the ozone layer, makes it even more volatile, and the sun's harmful ultraviolet rays enter our Earth's greenhouse and destroy the controlled conditions here.

That is, the temperature rises in our greenhouse when someone lights a furnace, and when the green cloth is torn, what happens to the middle crop is happening to the life on earth. In the same way, the condition of the animals, plants and, of course, the human beings, which is the condition of the butterflies roaming freely in the green house of a well-to-do rose by tearing this curtain and lighting the furnace, is inevitable.

If the curtain is sewn and the furnace is turned off, it is certain that the roses will bloom and the butterflies will fly again. Let us now consider exactly what needs to be done. Before that let us know the reasons for the origin of these gases.



Ø Solution - The solution is to either control the emissions of these gases and stabilize them by sequestration in a way that leaves no trace of their effects in the atmosphere. Animals take in oxygen and release carbon dioxide, while plants take in carbon dioxide and release oxygen. As long as the population was limited and forests and green cover were abundant, the proportion of these gases was kept in balance. This imbalance was further exacerbated by population explosion, deforestation and other causes of greenhouse gases. Their results will not only successfully neutralize, but also generate substantial income and help the nation to become self-sufficient in fuel. The details are as follows



Methane is an excellent fuel. What is special is that its burning does not harm the environment. Therefore, disaster can be converted into wealth by methane emitting elements and separation of methane by proper process. As a result, the country's fuel dependence is reduced and foreign exchange costs are saved. Instead, these funds are used domestically to strengthen the economy. To facilitate this, 'National Biofuels Policy 2018' has been prepared recently. Therefore, it is necessary for the self-governing bodies, societies, factories, hospitals, etc., to take proper advantage of the polluting elements and establish such a system.

We have already discussed the sources of carbon dioxide emissions, the measures to reduce them are to increase the use of unconventional and renewable alternative fuels such as solar, wind-, hydropower, use of fuel-efficient machinery, shift to water transport, maximize the use of public transport system. Apart from this, the emitted carbon is absorbed in the plant, so conservation of trees is the best solution. It is important to choose effective plants. Since bamboo is a very efficient plant in this regard, maximum bamboo cultivation can efficiently neutralize carbon.

- Ø Things to do on an individual level - use of plastic 100% avoidance, use of public transport system, maximum use of unconventional energy sources, organic farming by stopping the use of chemical fertilizers, complete vegetarianism Home Fertilizer - Fertilizer for backyard, biofuel preparation, waste segregation, wastewater recycling, tree care, tree felling, non-deforestation, radiation from electronic devices so use these tools as much as necessary, create green cover on waste land, green building Controlling climate change is not difficult if everyone adheres to the concepts of construction, maintaining personal and public hygiene, minimizing the use and consumption of water, using local goods (thus avoiding the harmful effects of fuel combustion for transportation), and stopping food spoilage (which emits methane).



Happily, the present governments are extremely sensitive to climate change control and are doing a great job in that regard. Massive generation of solar energy, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, electric vehicles, C.F.L. You will often find examples of planned use of bulbs, biofuel policy and promotion of energy from biological and urban waste, buses running on biofuels, special attention to water transport, special focus on project environment sensitization, empowerment of public transport system. In addition, at the recent Global Climate Change Conference in the United States, the Prime Minister emphasized the urgent need for all member states to make efforts to control climate change, and the member states responded.

All of the above has been discussed in this session. The students participated very well in this program. Presented your thoughts in front of others. Discussed climate change measures and you decide to try to save the environment

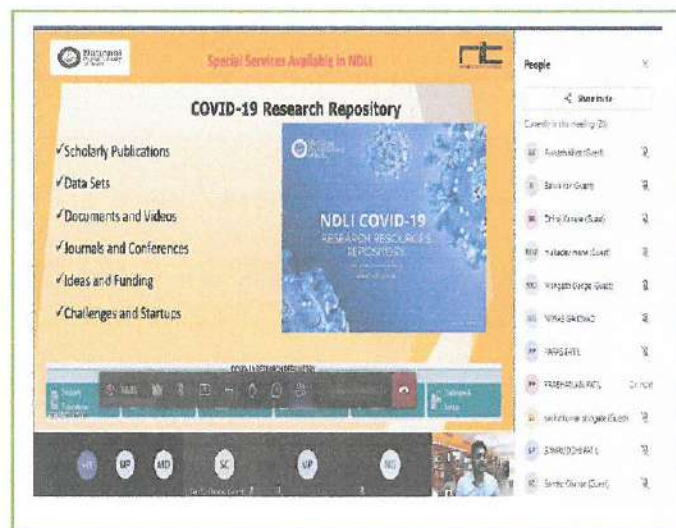
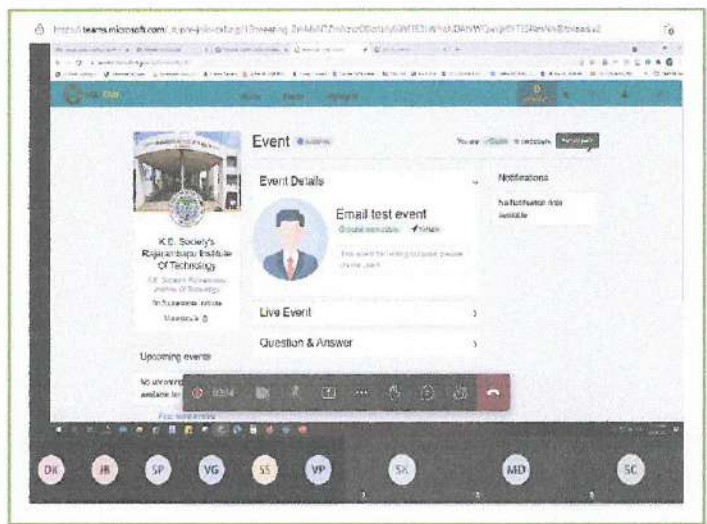
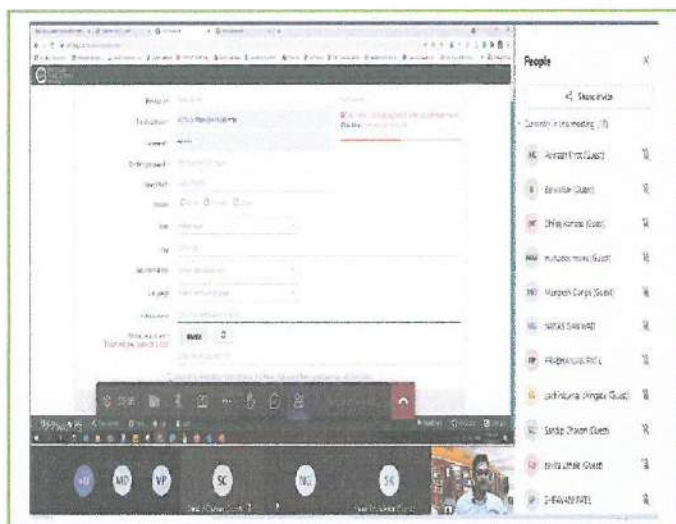
Librarian Mr. V. L. Hase has explained about the national digital library (NDL) and its uses. He also gave detailed information about how to register and access resources.

The Process of forming and registering group was from 7th October 2021 to 12th October 2021. Total 48 Students were registered.

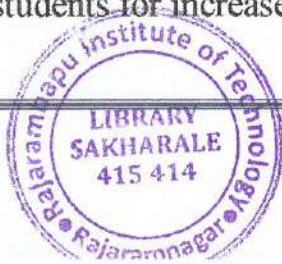
After that Central Library announced date for "Reading Club Book Poster Competition". In this Competition they have to present poster and book reviews in front of a judge and all students.

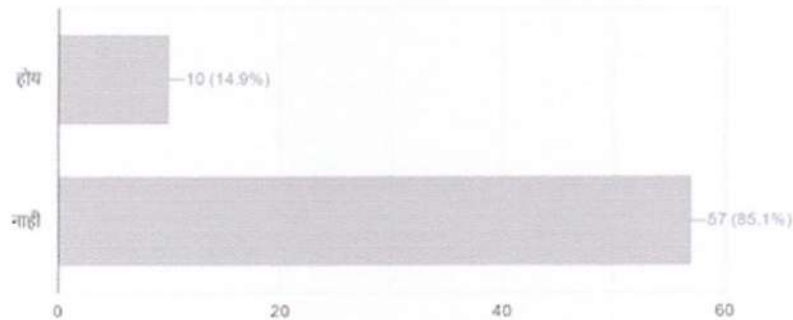

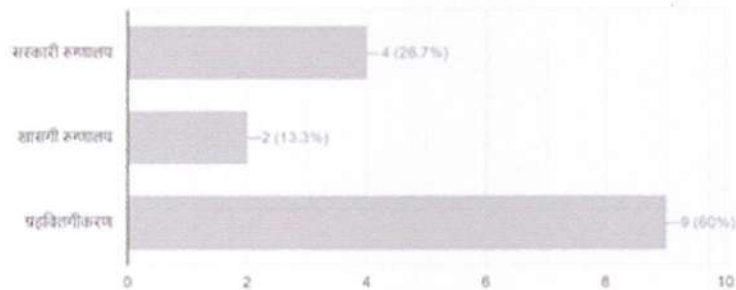

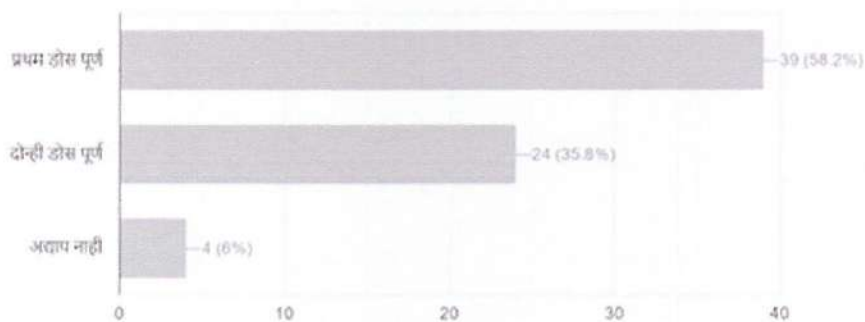

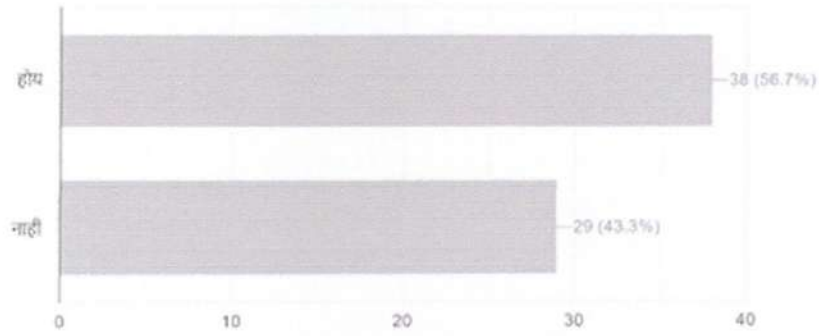

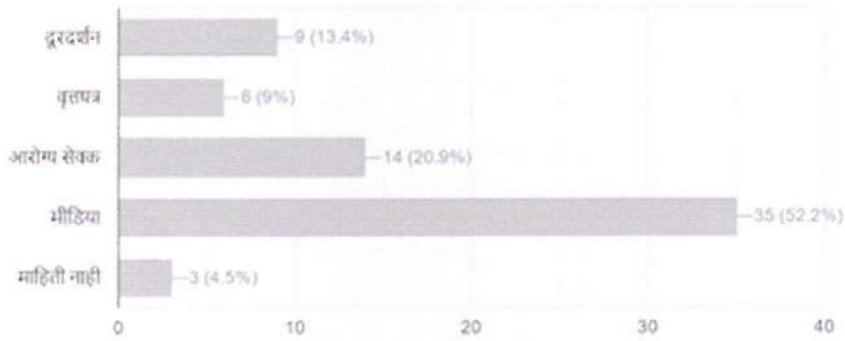

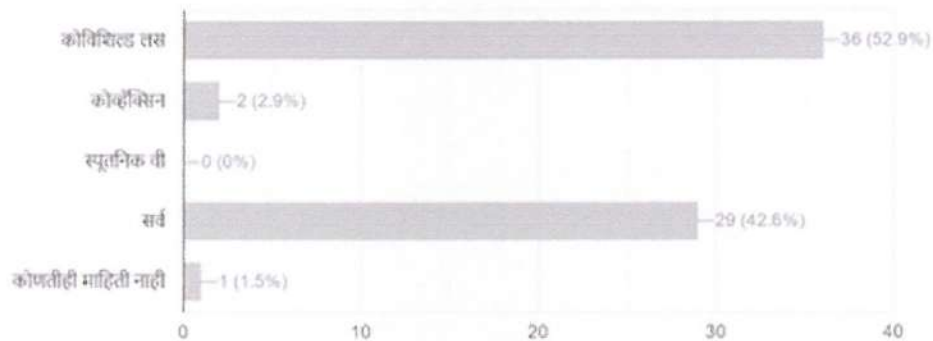

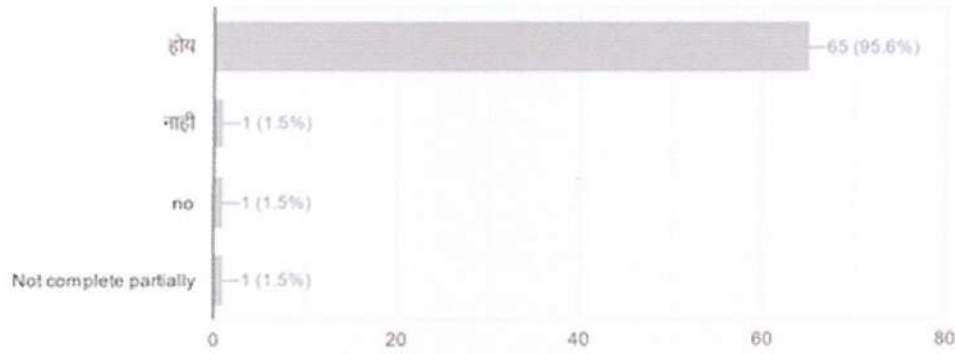

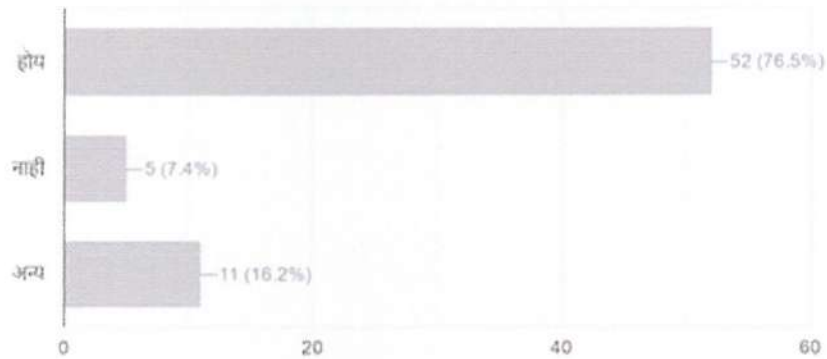

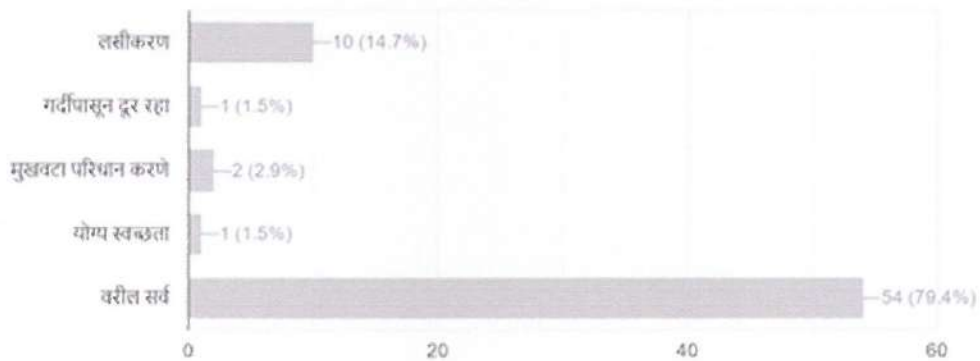

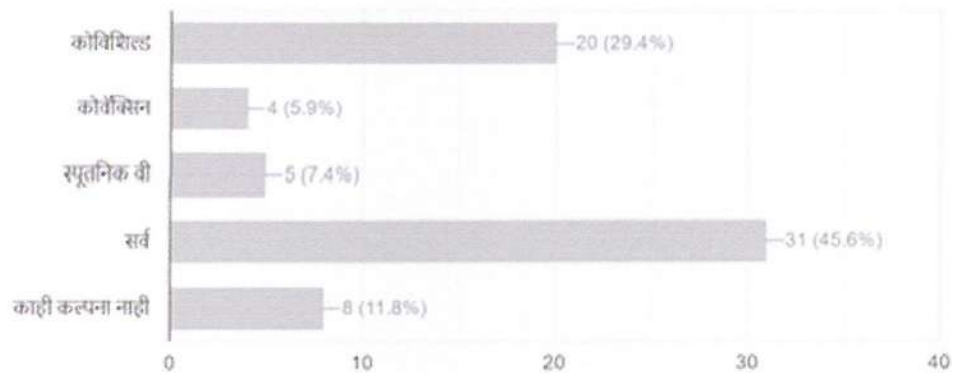

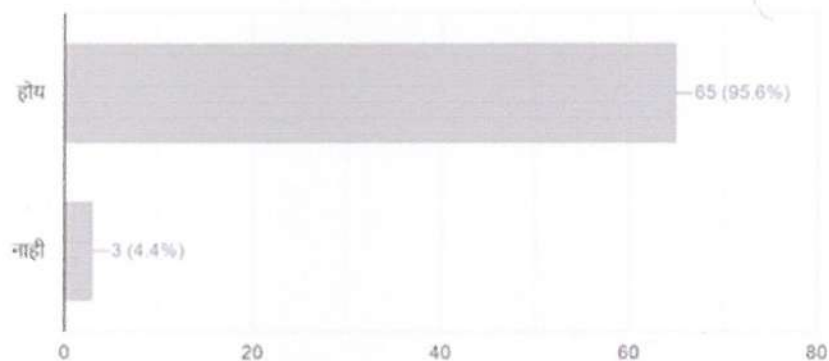

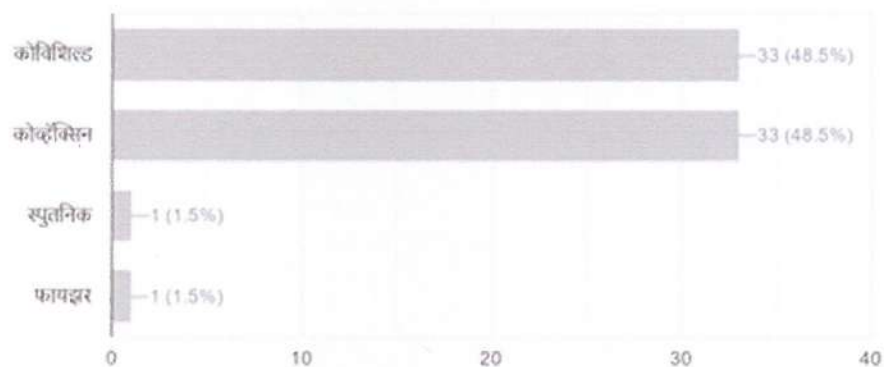

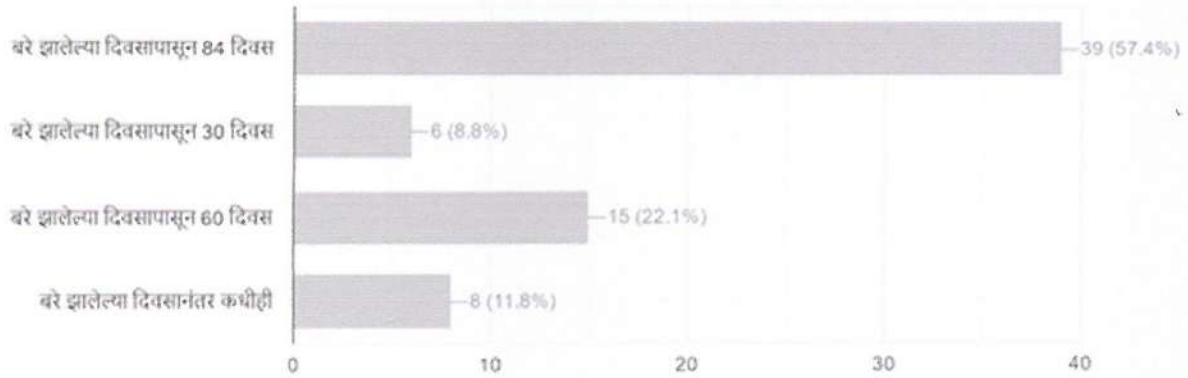

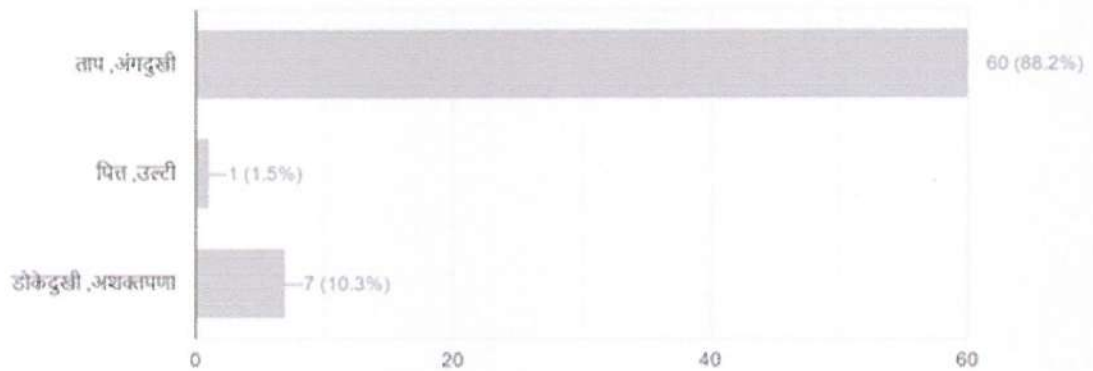

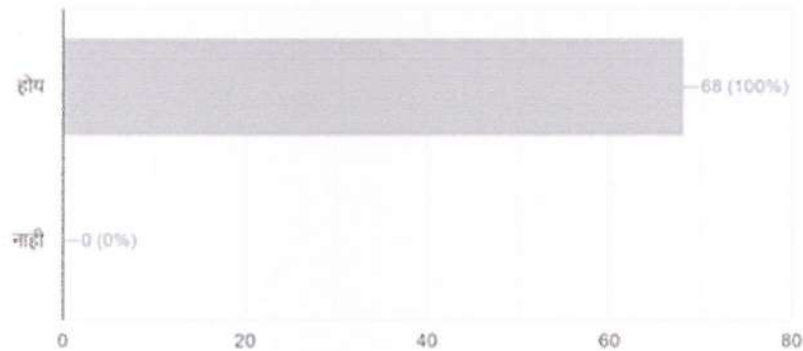

National Librarian's Day is observed on 12th August every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of **Padmashri Dr. S. R. Ranganathan** (1892-1972), who is considered as father of Library science in India. Dr. S. R. Ranganathan dedicated his entire life to library profession in India.

Dr. S. R. Ranganathan born on 9 August 1892 in the small town of Shiyali, in the state of Tamil Nadu in southern India. Dr. S. R. Ranganathan began his professional life as a Mathematician; he earned B.A. and M.A. degrees in mathematics from Madras Christian College. He established himself as a successful teacher of mathematics at Universities in Mangalore, Coimbatore and Madras within a span of five years. As a mathematics teacher, he published a handful of papers, mostly on the history of mathematics. After joining as University Librarian he went to England for library training. On coming back from England after his library training he was possessed by a mission to modernize Indian librarianship, university libraries and library science education. He saw librarians not as guardian of books but facilitator of their use for communication of information and creation of knowledge. To achieve this he worked at intellectual, administrative, political and social levels. The Government of India awarded Padmashri to Dr. S.R. Ranganathan for valuable contributions to Library Science.

On this occasion **RIT Central Library** organized **Book Exhibition** for the Users. The Exhibition inaugurated by **Director Dr. Mrs. S. S. Kulkarni** in presence of all Deans and HOD. The response from the students was admirable.

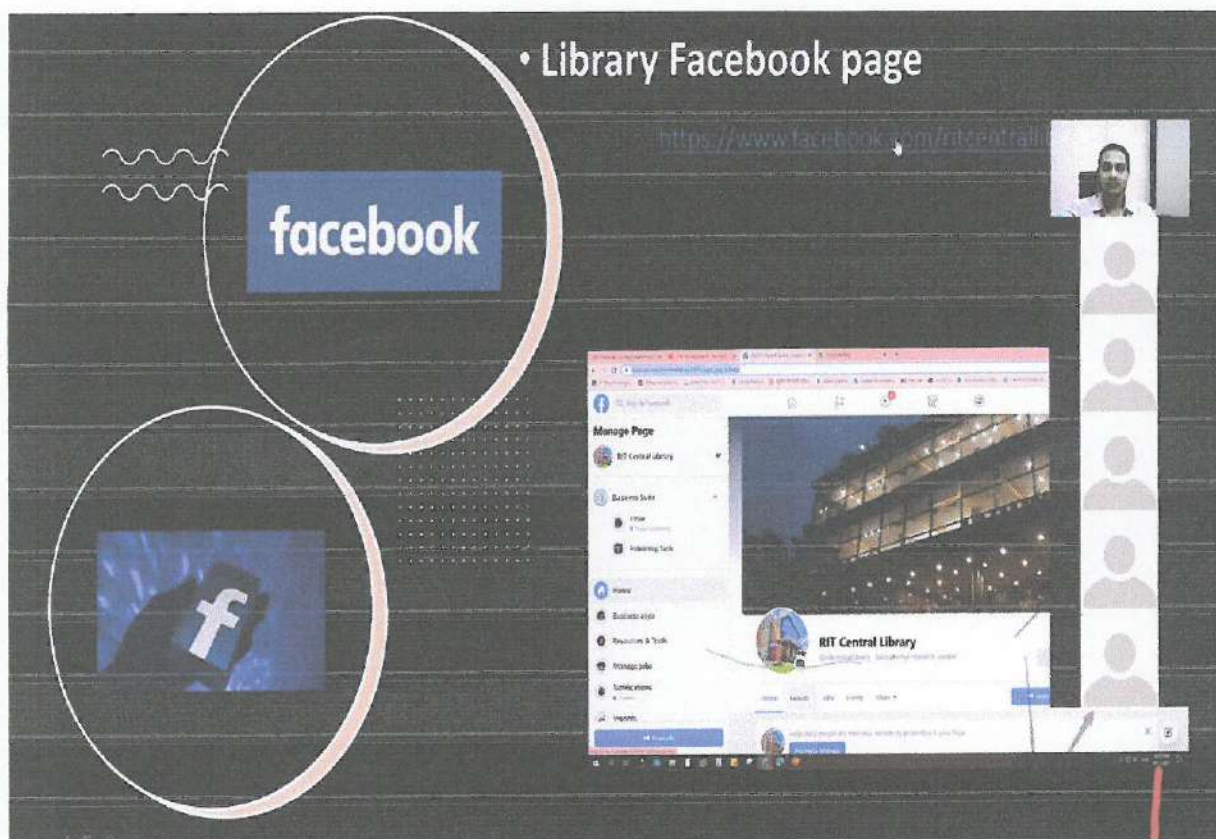
