





The objectives of project are to develop weld grinding robot for grinding straight (along the length for seam weld) and circular (at remote location where two pipes are joined) weld crown to clean surface for better coating on joined surface; To be able to grind the weld of variable diameter size of pipe staring from 100 mm to 250 mm and up to the length of 12 meters; To improve the fatigue life of the piping system by ensuring optimum size of weld crown; To provide wireless robotic system to avoid length of wire to pull along with robot; To provide attachment of coating thickness measurement device (DFT) and inspection camera along with robot for multifunctional advantage.
- 3. The proposal was duly processed and reviewed by the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) of RGSTC in its meeting dated $11^{th} 12^{th}$ March, 2020. The project proposal was approved by the Committee with suggestions to take 3 full time students to work on the project.
